Helpful Info You Need to Know



- **Ages For Camp VBS:** Camp VBS is for two different age groups of children. Younger children, which includes ages 2y/o through Kindergarten, will be picked up at 11:30am each day. Older children, which includes 1st-6th grade, will be picked up after field trips each day.
- **Cost:** The cost for 1st - 6th grade is \$65 per child. This includes snacks, field trips, transportation, materials for craft and teaching time, and a camp t-shirt. Registration is due by May 16. There will be a \$10 late fee for all registrations turned in after May 16. Camp shirts may not be available if you sign up after this date.
 - The cost for 2y/o - Kindergarten is FREE. Camp shirts are optional for this group at a cost of \$8.
- **Check In:** Camp check in begins at 8:00am each day at the main entrance to the church gym. Each child will be given their ID lanyard/sticker which they must wear at all times.
- **Pick Up:** You will need to sign your child out each day from their teacher when you pick them up. Children will only be released to individuals listed on your child's registration form. Please have photo identification ready for pick up.
- **Parking:** When dropping off or picking up your child please park in a parking space and walk your child to check in. Please do not pull up and park in front of the church or sidewalk. You must come in with your child.
- **Family Dinner:** NEW THIS YEAR, we are offering a FREE Family Dinner for everyone. During the Family Dinner, we will recap each day to see what your kids learned. The meal is FREE and must be signed up for on the registration form. We simply want to help you out with your busy schedule. The meal will be 30 minutes after pick up each day.
- **Curriculum:** The purpose of Camp VBS is to teach basic Biblical truths to each child with the help of Lifeway VBS curriculum. This year we will “spark” imagination and kick creativity into high gear at Spark Studios. Kids will learn that God's creativity didn't stop in Genesis. The Master Artist is working to redeem, reclaim, and transform us—His creation—to the design He planned for us. Kids will see the beautiful truth that they are God's workmanship as they learn to use their talents to bring glory to Him.
- **Daily Schedule:** Each day will begin with an exciting opening rally with worship, pledges, and Bible lesson. After the opening rally, the campers will rotate to different areas including recreation, music, missions, Minute to Win It, Bible study, and craft. Following rotations will be pick up for the younger kids and lunch time for the older kids. After lunch, we will load the buses and head to our afternoon field trips. Finally, we will return back to the church for pick up.
- **Clothing:** Camp t-shirts will be given out on the first day. For the older kids we ask that your child wear shoes, not flip flops. Flip flops are only allowed on Monday to the wave pool and Friday to Water Day. Also make a note of the back page and what is needed for specific field trips.
- **Lunches:** Older kids will be responsible for bringing their own packed lunch each day of camp. Please make sure their name is clearly marked on the bag. We will be providing afternoon snacks each day.
- **Field Trips:** (For Older Kids) T-shirts are required for our field trips on Tuesday (Steele Creek), Wednesday (Bright's Zoo), and Thursday (Just Jump). Children are also required to wear the name ID we provide. Transportation is provided and we will do our best to return to the church by the designated pick up time.
