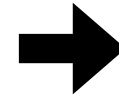

Helpful Info You Need to Know

- **Ages For Camp VBS:** Camp VBS is for two different age groups of children. Younger children, which includes ages 2y/o through Kindergarten, will be picked up at 11:30am each day. Older children, which includes 1st-5th grade, will be picked up after field trips each day.
- **Cost:** The cost for 1st-5th grade is \$65 per child. This includes snacks, field trips, transportation, materials for craft and teaching time, and a camp t-shirt. The cost for 2y/o - Kindergarten is FREE. Camp shirts are optional for this group at a cost of \$8. Registration is due by May 13. There will be a \$10 late fee for all registrations turned in after May 13. Camp shirts may not be available if you sign up after this date.
- **Check In:** Camp check in begins at 8:00am each day at the main entrance to the church gym. Each child will be given their ID lanyard/sticker which they must wear at all times.
- **Pick Up:** Pick up for 2y/o through Kindergarten will be on playground side of the church. You will enter through the carport door. Pick up for 1st-5th grade will be in the gym. Children will only be released to individuals listed on your child's registration form. Please have photo identification ready for pick up. No child will be released without photo identification.
- **Parking:** When dropping off or picking up your child please park in a parking space and walk your child to check in. Please do not pull up and park in front of the church or sidewalk. You must come in with your child.
- **Family Dinner:** We are offering a FREE family dinner for everyone. During the family dinner, we will recap each day to see what your child learned that day. The meal is FREE and must be signed up for on the registration form. We simply want to help you out with your busy schedule. The meal will be 30 minutes after pick up on Monday-Thursday.
- **Curriculum:** The purpose of Camp VBS is to teach basic Biblical truths to each child with the help of Lifeway VBS curriculum. Wave hello to Breaker Rock Beach! In a world full of shifting sands, kids will be challenged as they discover that God's truth never changes, everyone needs Jesus, and learn to speak the truth in love. Adventure awaits each day as kids explore tide pools, spot orcas, fly kites, and watch the mighty waves crash up against the immovable Breaker Rock!
- **Daily Schedule:** Each day will begin with an exciting opening rally with worship, pledges, and Bible lesson. After the opening rally, the campers will rotate to different areas including Recreation, Music, Missions, Game Show, Bible Study, Science, and Crafts. Following rotations will be pick up for the younger kids and lunch time for the older kids. After lunch, we will load the buses and head to our afternoon field trips. Finally, we will return back to the church for pick up.
- **Clothing:** Camp t-shirts will be given out on the first day. For the older kids we ask that your child wear shoes, not flip flops. Flip flops are only allowed on Monday to the Mammoth Waves and Friday to Water Day. Also make a note of the back page and what is needed for specific field trips.
- **Lunches:** Older kids will be responsible for bringing their own packed lunch each day of camp. Please make sure their name is clearly marked on the bag. We will be providing afternoon snacks each day. Younger kids will be picked up before lunch.
- **Field Trips:** (For Older Kids) T-shirts are required for our field trips on Tuesday (Steele Creek), Wednesday, and Thursday (Traveling Bear Indoor Mini Golf/Bristol Caverns). Children are also required to wear the name ID we provide. Transportation is provided and we will do our best to return to the church by the designated pick up time.
