- Mentor and invest personally in students, attending extracurricular activities.
- Model sacrificial love by spending time with students beyond scheduled activities.
- Organize and lead student trips and events.
- Build and nurture relationships with students, parents, and the church family.
- Be consistent in prayer, seeking God's will in all aspects of ministry.
- Hold students accountable with compassion and discipline in love.
- Work collaboratively as a team player with church staff and volunteers.
- Be an advocate for the student ministry to the adult congregation and staff.
